As part of the commitment to ensure security to the personnel, processes and the continuity of the operations, all parties (direct, contractors, suppliers and customers) must follow the standards and procedures, as well as the following aspects:

- Notify to the industrial protection department of any illicit action or activity that might affect the operations of the Prodeco Group.
- Comply with the policy, standards and procedures issue by the Industrial Protection Department.
- Report any action or event that might negatively affect the image and reputation of the Prodeco Group.

Failure to comply with this Policy will result in the application of disciplinary actions under according to the Prodeco Group's compliance and Human Resources programs.
